1. Eligibility – Pupils in Primary Schools or below, or under 11 on 1 July in the year before competition.
 2. Twenty yard wicket and 4.75 oz. Ball. Boundaries shall be a maximum of 40 yards.
 3. Each innings shall be a maximum of 20 overs, each bowler is limited to a maximum of 1/5 of the agreed overs.
 4. Results are to be notified **BY THE WINNING TEAM** to the Section Secretary within four days of the scheduled date of the match using an official Result Form which shall be completed in full detail. Any Club failing to do so will be fined £5.
 5. Any Section match not completed by the Monday week following the due date shall be declared void. Any team failing to fulfil a match, except for a reason beyond its control, shall be deemed to have lost the match, and shall be fined £10.
 6. Four points for a win and two for a tie. No points for abandoned or void games. Abandoned games should, if possible, be rearranged. The winner of a tied match in the knock-out stages shall be the team losing fewer wickets.
 7. In the knock-out stages up to and including Semi-Finals the first named team shall have home advantage. A knock-out fixture not played by reason of weather, or other reason by agreement of the Competition Secretary, shall be rearranged for a date on, or before, the following Monday. If both teams have travelled to the original venue for a Semi-Final and the match is not completed, it shall be rearranged for the original away venue. In the event of further postponement the match shall be decided by lot carried out by the Competition Secretary.
 8. Official Umpires will be appointed to the Finals of the Shield and Plate competitions. If a Final is postponed by reason of weather or ground conditions, the Competition Secretary shall set a date for the rearrangement. In the event of undue delay in completing a Final, the match will be declared void and the teams declared joint winners.
 9. In the event of equal points at the top of a Section between two teams the result between the teams will decide the winner. If more than two teams tie the winner shall be the tying team which has played the greater / greatest number of Section matches. If the teams are still tied, the winner shall be decided by lot carried out by the Competition Secretary.
1. ALL SECTIONS MUST BE COMPLETED BY 3 AUGUST 2008. It is the responsibility of the Home team to arrange a fixture. If the Clubs cannot agree a date, the Competition Secretary will set a date.

E.C.B. recommendation

It is recommended that no fielder who is under 13 years of age, except the wicket-keeper, shall be allowed to field nearer than 11 yards measured from the middle stump except behind the wicket on the off side, until the batsman has played at the ball.
